# We Finally Did It!

The Radar Challenge is over. And, judging from the results, Cincinnati Microwave won't be accusing us of advertising gambits or selling cheap imports any longer. Independent radar expert John Tomerlin voted Maxon's RD-25 'the best buy' among all of the radar detectors he tested. Read on to discover why.

The Radar Challenge is over. I think we've proven that Maxon's radar detectors are in the same league as Escort and Passport.

Based on the results of his exhaustive testing, independent radar expert John Tomerlin voted Maxon's RD-25 (pictured top right) 'the best buy' among all of the radar detectors he tested.

Tomerlin concluded that overall, the RD-25 sounded 'Continuous' and 'Full Alert' sooner than Passport. And, in the straight-away tests against K-band radar, it signaled its 'Full Alert' at a whopping 8,388 feet.

When you consider that the radar gun didn't lock on until 970 feet, at 65 mph, that's over a full minute of warning time, against K-band radar.

And, look at this. According to Tomerlin, all of Maxon's radar detectors 'demonstrated ample sensitivity to K and X-band radar.'

## SUPERHETERODYNE EXPLAINED

Superheterodyne technology is what catapults Maxon's radar detectors to the head of the radar detector pack.

A specially-designed circuit tests each suspected radar signal 4 separate times before it notifies you. And yet, it bursts into action in just 1/4 of a second (1/10 of a second for the RD-XL Micro-Trouncer).

And unlike VU meters that use a needle to indicate signal strength, Maxon's radar detectors use LED bars. They're so easy to read, you can monitor them with your peripheral vision, without taking your eyes off the road in front of you.

Plus, Maxon's dual conversion scanning superheterodyne circuitry really ferrets out radar signals.

You also won't be bothered by false alarms. The 4 test check system virtually

eliminates erroneous non-stable signals from other detectors, burglar alarms, garage door openers and electronic doors.

### ABOUT RADAR DETECTORS

Let's be honest. Today's well-made radar detectors are very similar. They all give you more than enough radar warning. What it really comes down to is price.

In Mr. Tomerlin's tests, Passport did a

little better at 'First Alert,' (which is more likely to be a false alarm). The RD-25 did better at 'Continuous' and 'Full Alert' (which are more likely to be a true radar signal). So, why pay more for less protection?

Maxon radar detectors come in three different sizes. First is the RD-1. It measures only 1 1/2"H. x 3 1/2"W. x 4 3/4"D. (Compared to Escort's 1 1/2"H. x 5 1/4"W. x 4 3/8"D.)

If you want a smaller radar detector, the 'Best Buy' RD-25 is just 1 1/2"H. x 2 7/8"W. x 4 1/2"D. and comes complete with a special windshield mount and two power cords (one coiled and one straight).

**Radar Note:** No matter what radar detector you use, in most cases, you'll get better sensitivity if you mount your detector at least 6 inches above the dashboard.

If you want to forget about power cords, then choose the RD-XL Micro-Trouncer. This 3/4"H. x 4 1/2"W. x 3 1/4"D. radar detector is so compact it fits in your shirt pocket for easy portability from car to car. (Passport is a little smaller at 3/4"H. x 2 3/4"W. x 4 1/2"D.)

With its included portable battery power pack (it runs on 6 included AA Ni-Cad rechargeable batteries), you'll 'cut' the radar cord for added convenience.

You'll also have Volume and City/Highway sensitivity controls. Plus, the RD-XL Micro-Trouncer has 'Mute' for silencing the alarm without adjusting the volume and a 'Dark'

switch for night driving.

All of Maxon's radar detectors are backed by Maxon's standard limited warranty.

**Special Note:** The use of radar detectors is illegal in some states. And, speeding is dangerous. Use your radar detector to keep you and your family safer, not to get away with speeding.
